

PONOKA COUNTY

BY-LAW 10-20-ICF

A By-Law of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta to adopt the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework of Ponoka County and Lacombe County.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, as amended, mandates that municipalities that have common boundaries must create an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework with each other that identifies the services provided by each municipality, which services are best provided on an intermunicipal basis, and how services to be provided on an intermunicipal basis will be delivered and funded;

AND WHEREAS Ponoka County and Lacombe County share a common border;

AND WHEREAS Ponoka County and Lacombe County share common interests and are desirous of working together to provide services to their residents;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of Ponoka County, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as the "Ponoka County–Lacombe County ICF By-Law"
2. That the Ponoka County–Lacombe County Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework, dated January 2020, as attached and forming part of this By-Law, be adopted.
3. This By-Law may be amended by By-Law in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended.
4. This By-Law shall become effective on the date of third and final reading.

Given first reading this 10th day of March, 2020 and was carried unanimously.

Given second reading this 10th day of March, 2020 and was carried unanimously.

By unanimous consent of Council to proceed at this time with third reading to By-Law 10-20-ICF;

By-Law 10-20-ICF was given third and final reading this 10th day of March, 2020 and was carried unanimously.
