

**PONOKA COUNTY**

**By-Law 13-17-RCA**

A Bylaw of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of adopting the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 / Ponoka County Intermunicipal Development Plan, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto.

**WHEREAS** the Councils of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 and Ponoka County have recognized the need to cooperate in the planning of future land use and development along the municipal boundary,

**AND WHEREAS** Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act provides for two or more municipalities to jointly prepare an intermunicipal development plan for an area of common interest or concern.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta, adopts the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 / Ponoka County Intermunicipal Development Plan, being the document attached hereto.

This By-Law comes into effect on the date of third reading.

Given first reading this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2017 and was carried unanimously.

Given second reading this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2017 and was carried unanimously.

By unanimous consent of Council to proceed at this time with third reading to By-Law 13-17-RCA;

By-Law 13-17-RCA was given third and final reading this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2017 and was unanimously passed.
