

PONOKA COUNTY

BY-LAW 16-19-IDP

A By-Law of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of adopting an Intermunicipal Development Plan for Gull Lake, with the Summer Villages of Gull Lake and Parkland Beach and Lacombe County, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto.

WHEARAS The Councils of Ponoka County, Lacombe County, the Summer Village of Parkland Beach and the Summer Village of Gull Lake have recognized the need to cooperate in the planning of future land use and development along the shared common municipal boundary;

AND WHEREAS Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act provides for two or more municipalities to jointly prepare an intermunicipal development plan for an area of common interest or concern.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Ponoka County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as the "Gull Lake IDP By-Law".

2. The Intermunicipal Development Plan of Ponoka County, Lacombe County, the Summer Village of Parkland Beach and the Summer Village of Gull Lake, as amended, attached to this By-Law as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.

3. This By-Law may be amended by By-Law in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, as amended.

4. This By-Law shall come into effect on the date of the third and final reading.

Given first reading this 13th day of August, 2019 and was carried unanimously.
