

PONOKA COUNTY

BY-LAW 20-18-IDP

A By-Law of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of adopting the Intermunicipal Development Plan of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach and Ponoka County, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS the Councils of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach and Ponoka County have recognized the need to cooperate in the planning of future land use and development along the share common municipal boundary;

AND WHEREAS Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act provides for two or more municipalities to jointly prepare an intermunicipal development plan for an area of common interest or concern;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Ponoka County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as the "IDP By-Law".
2. The Intermunicipal Development Plan of the Summer Village of Parkland Beach and Ponoka County, attached to this By-Law as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.
3. This By-Law may be amended by By-Law in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, as amended.
4. This By-Law come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.

Public Hearing required by the Act conducted on September 25, 2018.

Given first reading this 25th day of September, 2018 and was carried unanimously.

Given second reading this 25th day of September, 2018 and was carried unanimously.

By unanimous consent of Council to proceed at this time with third reading to By-Law 20-18-IDP;

By-Law 20-18-IDP was given third and final reading this 25th day of September, 2018 and was unanimously passed.
