



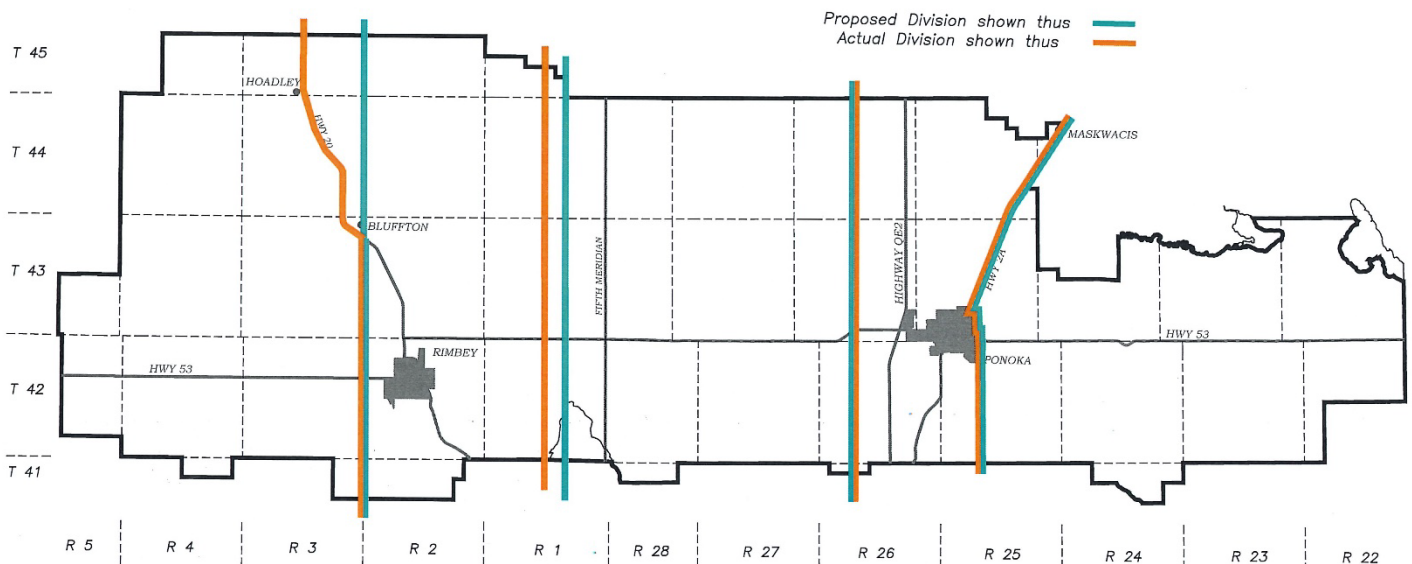
Ponoka County

Divisional Boundaries

Upon reviewing the most recent census results, County Council noted quite a discrepancy with the population statistics per division. In order to rectify this, Council has proposed that the divisional boundaries be adjusted to distribute the population more evenly as per the map below.

In accordance with the Municipal Government Act, any change to boundaries must be advertised allowing the electors to review the changes and petition Council for or against the change. Any petition must be presented to County Council **prior to January 16, 2023** (60 days after the last publication of this notice). Council will consider adopting the new divisions to become effective for the 2024 Municipal Election.
