

PONOKA COUNTY

BY-LAW 3-18-ICF

A By-law of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of adopting the Ponoka County / Camrose County Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS Section 708.28(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, as amended, mandates that municipalities that have common boundaries must create an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework with each other that identifies the services provided by each County, which services are best provided on an intermunicipal basis, and how services to be provided on an intermunicipal basis will be delivered and funded;

AND WHEREAS Ponoka County and Camrose County share a common border;

AND WHEREAS Ponoka County and Camrose County share common interest and are desirous of working together to provide services to their residents;

AND WHEREAS Ponoka County and Camrose County consulted with residents of both Counties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Ponoka County, in the Province of Alberta, adopts the Ponoka County / Camrose County Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework, being the document attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law.

This By-Law come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.

Given first reading this 9th day of January, 2018 and was carried unanimously.

Given second reading this 9th day of January, 2018 and was carried unanimously.

By unanimous consent of Council to proceed at this time with third reading to By-Law 3-18-ICF;

By-Law 3-18-ICF was given third and final reading this 9th day of January, 2018 and was unanimously passed.
