B. That an election will be held for the election of a Senate nominee for the purposes of the *Alberta Senate Election Act*;

C. That a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum question(s) under the *Referendum Act*;

- a. Should Section 36(2) of the *Constitution Act, 1982* – Parliament and the government of Canada’s commitment to the principle of making equalization payments – be removed from the Constitution?
- b. Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one or more of:

- one piece of identification issued by a Canadian government, whether federal, provincial or local, or an agency of that government, that contains a photograph of the person, the person’s name and the address of the person’s residence;
- or one piece of identification that establishes the person’s name and current address.
